Rules and Regulations

1. All riders must wear correct headgear (PAS 015 recommended).
2. Strathisla Riding Club and the landowners accept no responsibility for any loss or damage or injury to the public, their vehicles, property or any horse or rider.
3. The decision of the judge is final in every case. Any competitor, or groom guilty of disobedience/rudeness to any judge, official or steward will be disqualified. Entry fees will not be returned.
4. In the Ridden/WH classes - horses will be ridden at the judges discretion.
5. Horses must be treated with dignity and respect at all times.
6. Entries received will not be refunded after the closing date except on production of a veterinary certificate.
7. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
8. **IT IS THE COMPETITORS RESPONSIBILITY TO BE AT THE RINGSIDE IN TIME FOR EACH OF THEIR CLASSES. IN THE UNFORTUNATE EVENT OF CLASSES CLASHING THE COMPETITOR MUST CHOOSE WHICH TO COMPETE IN - NO REFUND WILL BE GIVEN.**
9. **The making of an entry implies acceptance of all the rules and regulations.**
10. Please keep the show ground as you find it, clean of droppings and hay.
11. **Eligibility:** Horses must be 15hh and over. Horses must not have won more than £400 in total in any WH competitions, more than £400 in BS winnings or have more than 45 BE points. Riders must be 18yo or over on 1 Jan 2017

Course: You will be asked to jump a course of 8-12 fences approx 3'3" in height. Classes will be judged in line with Sport Horse Breeding Society of GB rules. You can [download a copy of the rules here](#) (download the Show Regulations from the Forms section). Hats must conform to the BRC rulebook.

Qualification: The first three partnerships in each qualifier will qualify for the final even if they did not jump clear. If one of the first three has already qualified, their qualification can be passed down to the fourth placed horse and rider provided they jumped clear. To be eligible for the final, the rider must be a member of a riding club affiliated to BRC.

To compete at the FINAL riders must be a Riding Club member.
